One Full Term's In-State Tuition Remission Fellowship

The Asian Studies Center (ASC) invites applications for the Student Engagement Intern. Applicants must be a currently enrolled Asian Studies certificate student of outstanding ability (QPA of 3.0 or above) for a tuition remission fellowship in the amount of one term's in-state tuition for the 2017-2018 academic year.

The recipient of the fellowship will be required to work ten hours per week during the fall and spring terms. He/she will assist the Program Assistant and ASC staff with engaging students and promoting center events especially through social media platforms.

DUTIES

- 1. Development and weekly creation of a digital newsletter publicizing ASC activities and programs
- 2. Frequent and coordinated posting on social media (Twitter, Facebook)
- 3. Collect analytics and data of student, event and alumni data for reporting purposes
- 4. Assist in development and oversight of promotional materials including print and digital content
- 5. Event documentation including photography and audio/video recording
- 6. Maintain ASC databases (faculty, students, community)
- 7. Liaison with Pitt student groups
- 8. Event set up and clean up as needed
- 9. Other duties as assigned

PRIMARY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Fluency in English (writing is especially important)
- 2. Outgoing personality and an interest in interacting with students
- 3. Ability to maintain and produce content for social media (Twitter, Facebook, Mailchimp)
- 4. Strong computer skills, especially Microsoft Office (Word, Excel, Publisher)
- 5. Self -starter who can multi-task

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS

- 1. Strong photography skills
- 2. Graphic design abilities

BENEFITS

The Student Engagement Intern will receive tuition remission in the amount of one term's in-state tuition for the 2017-2018 academic year. The award can be applied to the fall OR spring terms. S/he will have the opportunity to network with ASC faculty and students and develop their public relation skills.
