



## UNDERGRADUATE TEACHING FELLOWSHIP

The Center for Latin American Studies (CLAS) is pleased to offer undergraduates the opportunity to enrich their educational experience, enhance their resumé, and receive a cash award of \$750. The CLAS Undergraduate Teaching Fellowship for the **Spring 2010** will be awarded to an outstanding undergraduate currently enrolled in Latin American Studies to assist a professor in teaching a Latin American course.

To apply, the student and the CLAS faculty member must present the following documents:

1. Nomination of a student for the award should be done by the faculty member in a maximum of three pages and should include:
  - (a) how the student will participate in the course and;
  - (b) how the student's involvement is expected to contribute to implementation of teaching innovation otherwise not possible without the time commitment of an assistant.
2. The student should submit a statement (three-page maximum) defining his/her own goals in the course;
3. The student should submit a current academic transcript (an unofficial copy is acceptable);
4. *One* letter of recommendation of the student's qualifications to serve as a teaching fellow should be submitted by a faculty member other than the sponsor;
5. The student's name, local and home addresses, phone numbers, and email address should be included in the application.

Applications for the fellowships should be marked *Undergraduate Teaching Fellowship* and sent to Julian Asenjo, Center for Latin American Studies, 4200 Posvar Hall.
