

Study/Internship Abroad Opportunity for Business Students

The Center for Russian and East European Studies (REES) is pleased to announce a new initiative to all interested CBA students: Any CBA student who enrolls in Pitt's Slavic and East European Summer Language Institute (SLI) will be assisted, upon request, with arranging visits to local companies and/or a two-week internship experience in the target country upon completion of the language program. CBA students taking REES languages during the academic year may participate in an overseas internship as well. The following languages are eligible: **Russian, Polish, Bulgarian, Hungarian, Slovak, Bosnian/Croatian/Serbian, Ukrainian, Czech, Modern Greek, and Turkish.**



The SLI is a set of intensive, proficiency-oriented summer language programs, which provide 6 to 10 Pitt credits and the equivalent of one full academic year of language learning. Completing such a program will add an immediate international focus to your business studies and allow you to explore foreign business developments or conduct research in foreign languages.

Presently, there are five study abroad programs offered in the SLI:

- **Pitt to Moscow (beginning through fourth-year levels)**
- **Pitt to Poland (beginning and intermediate levels)**
- **Pitt to Bulgaria (beginning and intermediate levels)**
- **Pitt to Slovakia (beginning through advanced levels)**
- **Advanced Mastery Bosnian/Croatian/Serbian in Belgrade, Zagreb and Sarajevo**

Additional summer language classes are offered on the University of Pittsburgh campus.

All students who apply to the SLI programs are eligible for scholarships. In previous years, over 90% of SLI students have received some form of scholarship. CBA students pursuing an internship abroad will be considered for additional financial assistance.
