






Figure 1: First time asylum applicants, EU-28, January 2014 – December 2015 - Source: Eurostat




First time asylum applicants by citizenship, absolute change between Q4 2014 and Q4

- Dampening "generators"






Right-wing populism: the real tail risk in Europe






Growth projections for 2015-16






Greek Economy


Refugee Routes to Greece
