Global Studies has a limited amount of funds available for Tuition Remission Fellowships (TRFs). TRFs may pay a partial or full term's tuition. **The closing date for applications for TRFs for spring term 2008 is December 3, 2007.** Winners will be announced in mid December and will be expected to begin their Fellowship immediately after returning from winter break. The scholarship amount will be credited to the student's PeopleSoft account for the 2084 term (Spring 2008). Student Fellows will be required to work a maximum of 10 hours per week during that term.

Duties

Student Fellows will support the Global Studies Program in projects relating to student recruitment and/or on-going or new Global Studies initiatives.

Requirements

1. Must be currently enrolled in, and must demonstrate progress towards completing, one of the following: Undergraduate Certificate, Graduate Certificate, or Bachelor of Philosophy in International and Area Studies (BPhil-IAS), Global Studies Track.
2. Minimum QPA: Undergraduate Certificate students: 3.0; Graduate Certificate and BPhil students: 3.25. Note: First-term students are not eligible for TRFs; please apply after grades for the first term have been received.
3. Ability to present information to students and organizations (good public speaking and presentation abilities); strong interpersonal skills for work with other students.

Benefits

Partial or full tuition remission for one academic term.

2. Cover letter explaining the ways in which you are qualified and the reasons you want this Fellowship
