We are pleased to announce the Global Studies' Tuition Remission Fellowships (TRFs) for our certificate students contingent upon funding. TRFs may pay a partial or full term's tuition. **The closing date for applications for TRFs for Spring Term 2012 is December 5, 2011.** Winners will be expected to begin their Fellowship within the second week of the Fall term. The scholarship amount will be credited to the student's PeopleSoft account for the 2124 term (Spring 2012). Student Fellows will be required to work a maximum of 10 hours per week during the term by assisting with guest lectures, films and weekend outreach workshops; student recruitment; and other special projects.

Requirements

1. Must be currently enrolled in, and must demonstrate progress towards completing, one of the following: Undergraduate Certificate, Graduate Certificate, or Bachelor of Philosophy in International and Area Studies (BPhil-IAS), Global Studies Track.
2. Minimum QPA: Undergraduate Certificate students: 3.0; Graduate Certificate and BPhil students: 3.25. Note: First-term students are not eligible for TRFs; please apply after grades for the first term have been received.
3. Must be able to demonstrate professional work etiquette including: strong interpersonal, public speaking and writing skills, work independently, arrive promptly and the ability to take initiative.

Benefits

Partial or full tuition remission for one academic term.
