- Covers travel, lodging, and in-country hosting fees
- Open to students from all Schools of the Health Sciences
- Ideal for projects involving meaningful service in underserved global communities

### **Eligibility**

- Enrolled in one of Pitt's Health Sciences programs (Medicine, Nursing, Public Health, Dental Medicine, Pharmacy, or Health and Rehabilitation Sciences)
- Projects focused on resource-poor settings, with an emphasis on Africa (especially Kenya)
- Commitment to ethical and culturally competent global engagement

- **Deadline for 2024–2025:** Rolling until a suitable candidate is identified
- **Future Years:** Applications due in early fall
- **Application Requirements:**
  - Online application form
  - Personal statement addressing global health goals
  - Letter of support from a faculty mentor
  - Proposed budget
