- Amount: \$ 5,000
- Covers travel, lodging, and in-country hosting fees
- Open to students from all Schools of the Health Sciences
- Ideal for projects involving meaningful service in underserved global communities

Eligibility

- Enrolled in one of Pitt's Health Sciences programs (Medicine, Nursing, Public Health, Dental Medicine, Pharmacy, or Health and Rehabilitation Sciences)
- Projects focused on resource-poor settings, with an emphasis on Africa (especially Kenya)
- Commitment to ethical and culturally competent global engagement
