16003 ENGLISH ENGFLM 400 INTRODUCTION TO FILM Barden, Eve Evgeniya

Session: 6W1 TTh 6:00 PM to 9:50 PM WEBTBA 3 Credits

This is a basic course on the visual arts that offers the student abroad introduction to the medium of film. As part of this overview, the class will consider such issues as: the process of contemporary film production and distribution; the nature of basic film forms; selected approaches to film criticism; comparisons between film and the other media.

20090 FILMST FMST 170 WORLD FILM HISTORY Titus,Nikhil Thomas Session: 6W1 MW 12:00 PM to 3:50 CL 232 3 Credits PM

This course both introduces students to techniques of film analysis and acquaints them with major works and movements in international cinema. The course pays particular attention to the evolution of film narrative and visual style through landmarks in film development--European avant-garde films, British documentary, Italian neorealism, etc. This is a Critical Studies course and is a required course for the Film and Media Studies major and minor. We will pay special attention to the historical relationship between film and politics and additionally stress the question of film genres.

17061 GERMANIC GER 1502 INDO-EUROPEAN FOLKTALES Brand, Benjamin Martin Wilhelm
Session: 6W1 MWF 10:00 AM to 12:15 WEBTBA 3 Credits

This course introduces students to both a wide selection of Indo-European folktales as well as numerous perspectives from which to understand these folktales. We will examine the aesthetic, social, historical, and psychological values that these tales reflect. In addition, we will discuss significant theoretical and methodological paradigms in the field of folklore studies, including structural, socio-historical, psychoanalytic, and feminist perspectives. Finally, we will analyze the continuing influence of this folk tradition on popular and high culture of our time. Upon completion of this course, the students should be familiar with a wide variety of Indo-European folktales, be able to discuss several approaches to studying them, be able to identify the most important motifs of these tales, be familiar with some of the most influential folklorists, writers, and editors of the tales, and be able to assess the significance of folktales for contemporary western culture. This course satisfies General Education requirements for Literature and Specific Geographic Region in the School of Arts and Sciences

20613 HIST HIST 125 RELIGIONS OF THE WEST Brady, Joel Christopher Session: 6W1 TTh 6:00 PM to 9:15 PM WEBTBA 3 Credits

This course is a historical introduction to the religious traditions that developed in ancient Near East and the Mediterranean. Our major emphasis is on the history of the religious traditions that emerged in late antiquity in this area and which continue to be major world religions: Judaism, Christianity, and Islam. We will also touch on Zoroastrianism. We focus on key concepts, historical developments, and contemporary issues. Throughout the course, we also examine interactions among these religious traditions. In the last part of the course we examine the issue of globalization and the spread of these religions around the world as well as the presence of "non-Western" religion in the "West." The course also serves as an introduction to the academic study of religion and provides a foundation for further coursework in Judaism, Christianity, and Islam. No prior knowledge of any of the religions studied is expected or assumed.

Summer 2021 *All work will be completed online and asynchronously.* In this course, we will survey the causes, conduct and conclusion of World War II in Europe. We will emphasize such topics as nationalism, racism, and propaganda and their roots in the nineteenth century. We will talk about the development of the modern armaments industry and arms races as they played out in the era before the Second World War. We will explore models of conflict and peace that have defined debates about international relations for the past two hundred years, and we will see how these ideas influenced international competition, alliance systems, the establishment of the League of Nations, interwar appearement, and the foundation of the United Nations. We will think about wartime dynamics, spending time examining the changing ideals of war and relating these trends to technological development and growing industrial capacity on the one hand, and changing social and political attitudes on the other hand. We will seriously engage the topic of the relationship between culture and war by reading many types of sources, by examining images and films and even architecture, and by listening to radio addresses and viewing newsreel footage. In addition to discussing battles in the European theater and exploring the experiences of the soldiers in battle, we will think about the impact of war on civilians and the role of civilians during war, in resistance and in collaboration. We will talk about the origins and experience of the Holocaust, and about guilt, responsibility and memory. Throughout the course, we will examine the constant human struggle between our ideals and our reality. The course concludes with an analysis of the postwar settlement and the onset of the Cold War.

Few aspects of the human experience are as universal as food. We all eat it, we all cook it (or order it), and we all can't live without it. This course will explore some of the most salient themes of modern history—imperialism, colonialism, nationalism, war, and revolution—through the lens of food history. It will position food as both a product and a catalyst of human decision-making, exploring the ways in which what and how we eat has shaped our modern world. Since eating is at once a shared and a deeply personal experience, this course will give you an opportunity to situate your own food habits and traditions into wider global processes. You will not only be reading and talking about food, but also eating it, experimenting with it, and interrogating it, gaining deeper insights into your own food histories.

20617 HIST HIST 1775 ORIGINS OF CHRISTIANITY Denova, Rebecca I Session: 6W1 TTh 2:00 PM to 5:15 PM WEBTBA 3 Credits

This course presents a historical-critical investigation of Christian origins. Special attention is paid to varieties of 1st century Hellenistic and Palestinian Judaism within the Greco-Roman world. PS PS 1389 COMPETING PERSPECTIVE ON Crafword, Tim GLOBAL WATER POLICY Rukhadze, Vasili 5/17-5/21/2021 WEBTBA 1 Credits

Competing Perspectives on Global Water Policy: From the United States to Central Asia (PS1389)
This course provides undergraduate students interested in the fields of Environmental Studies, Business, Law,
Engineering, Public Policy and other areas with a first-hand experience of the global impact of contemporary
developments in the water policy sector. Competing Perspectives on Global Water Policy will introduce students to
the role of governmental and non-governmental organizations managing water equity, enabling them to study
interconnections between policy, law, economics, and culture related to the environment. Students will develop a
portfolio of varied writing samples to use in applications for graduate programs and careers in policy while also
creating their network of experts and organizations influential to the shaping of water and environmental policy in
the U.S., Central Asia, and globally. This course is open to undergraduate and non-PITT students. Coursework may
count towards certificates provided by the Center for Russian, East European, and Eurasian Studies, the Global
Studies Center, and the Mascaro Center for Sustainable Innovation.
