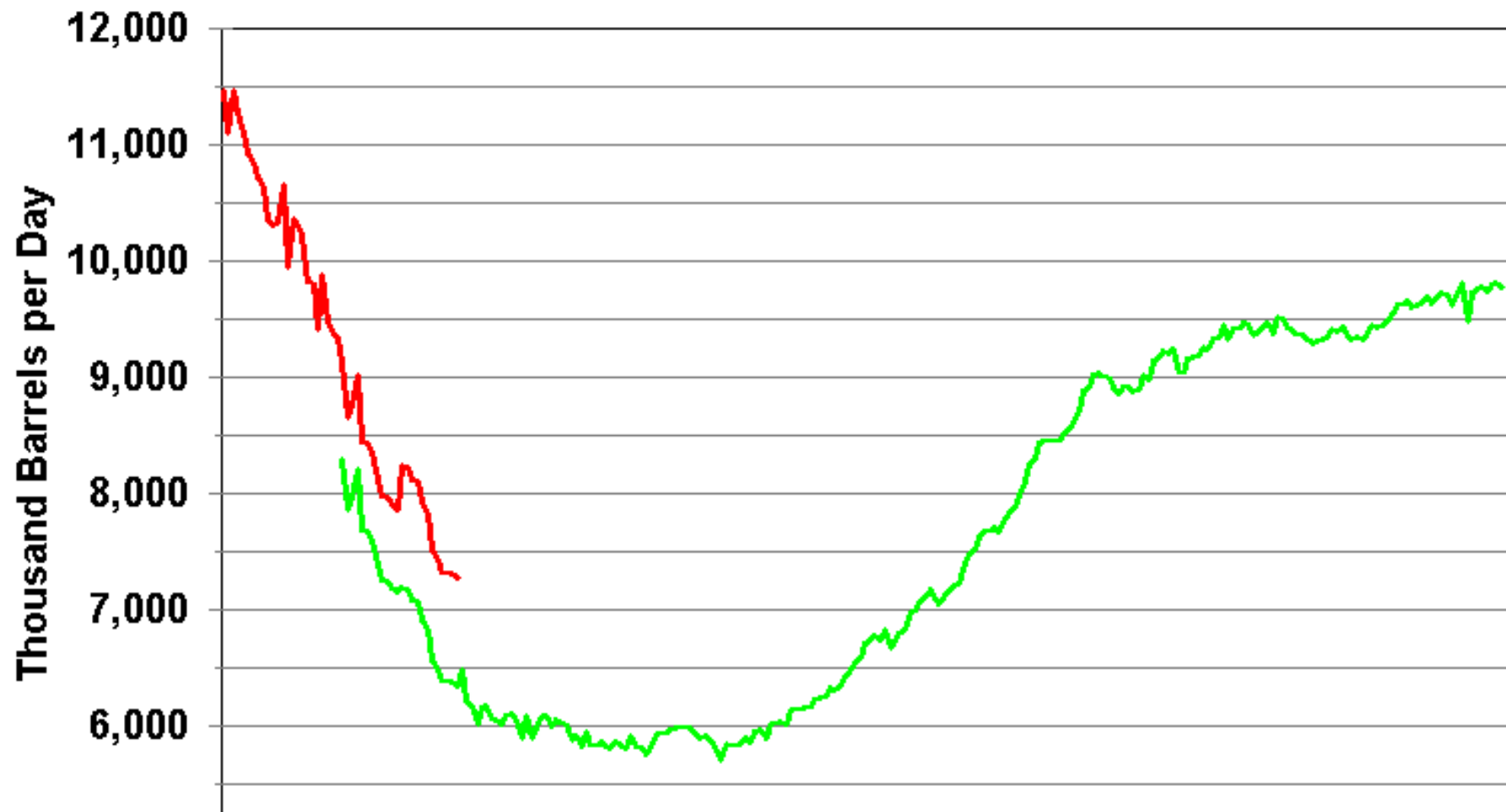

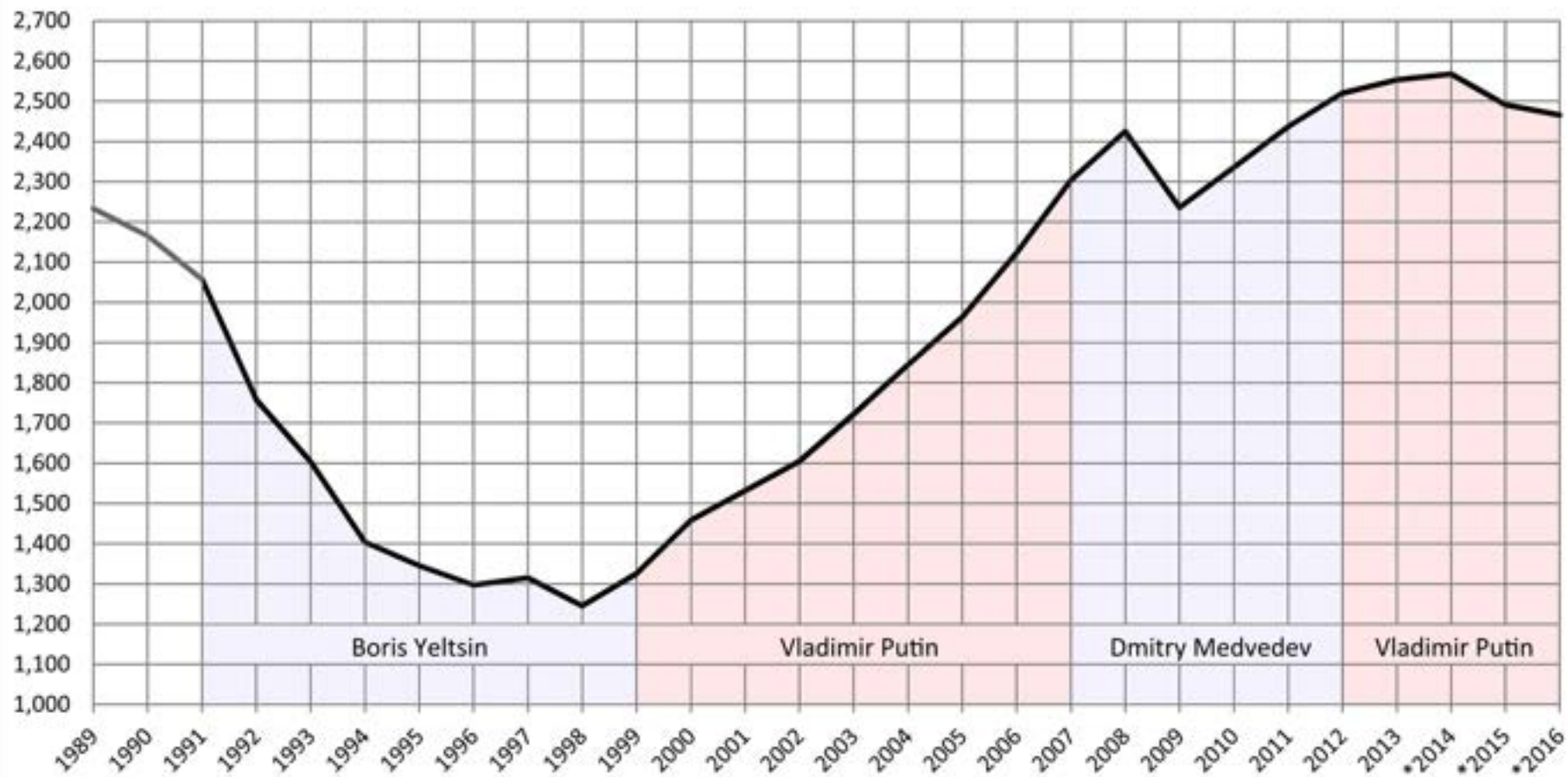
# Crude Oil and Condensate Production Russia & USSR

Billions of USD (2013)

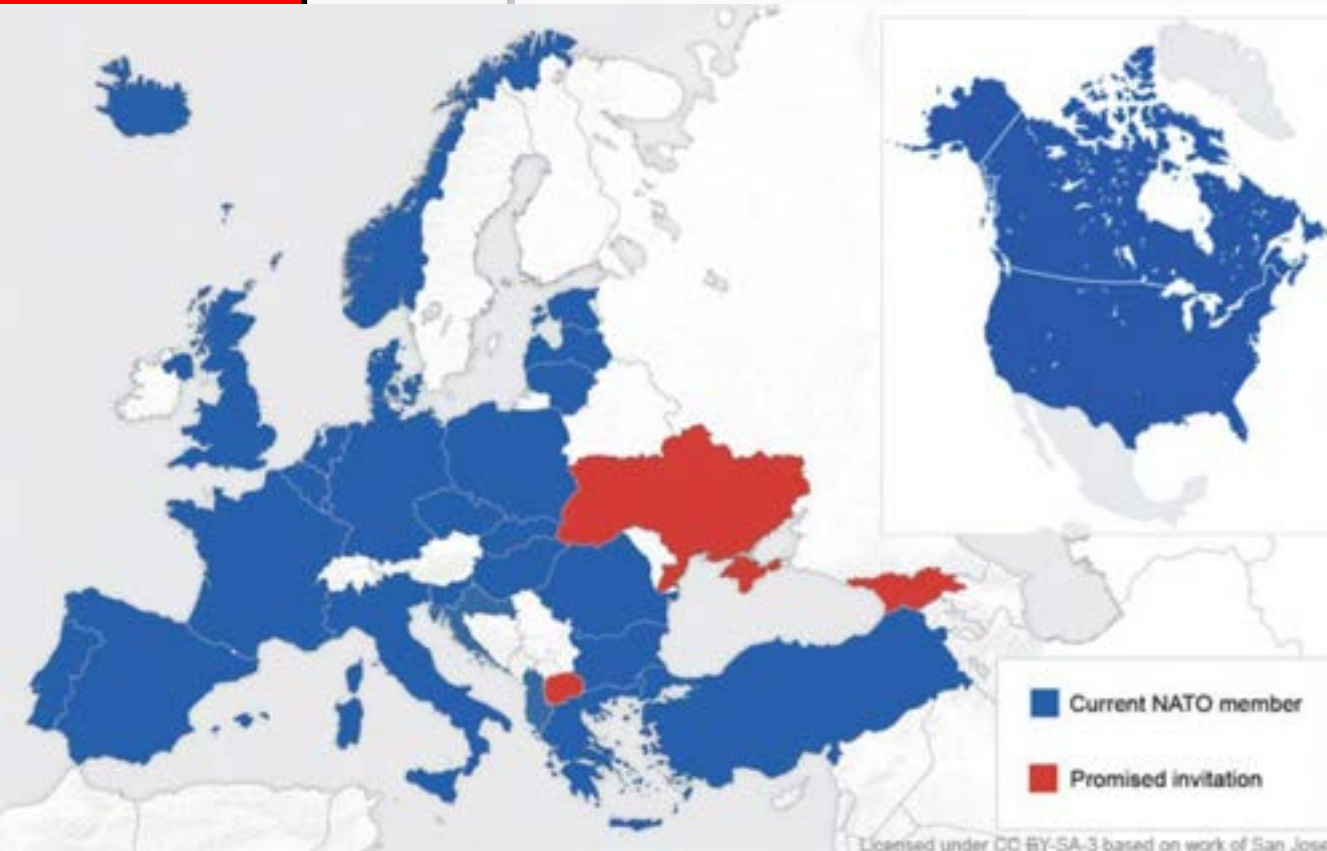

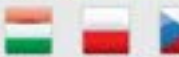

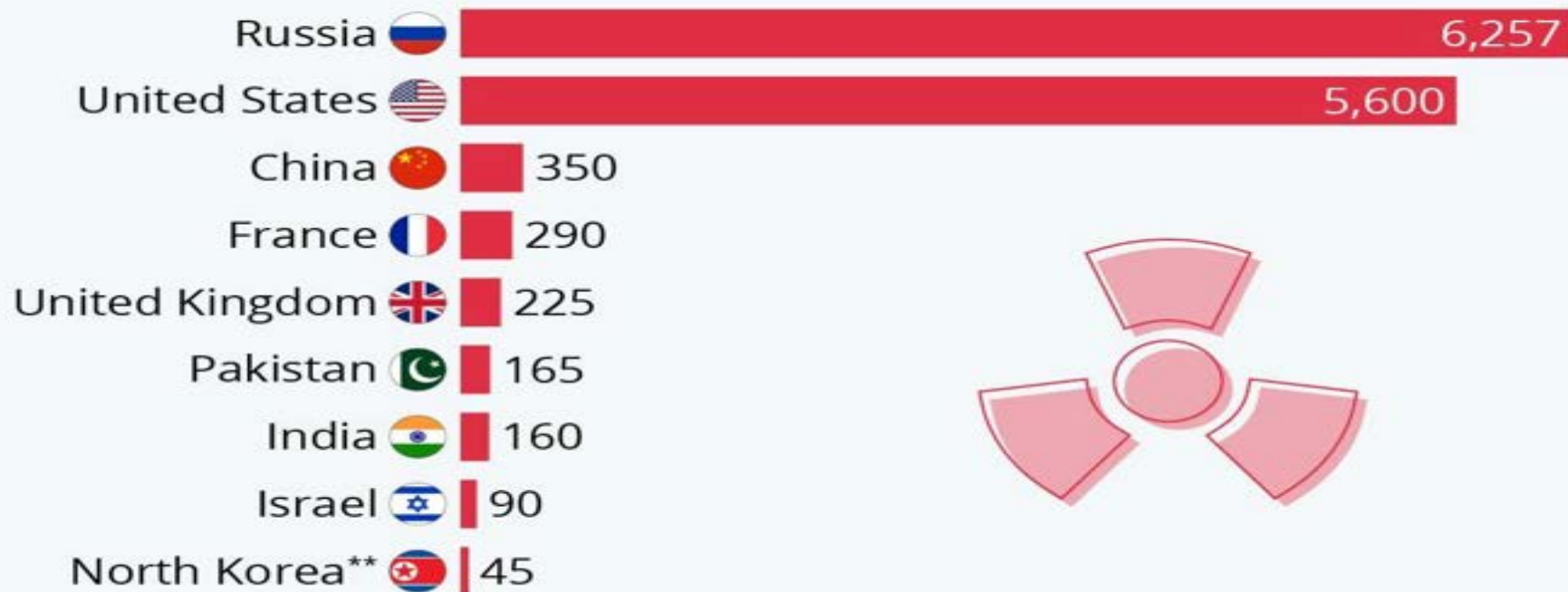

European Union and NATO\* membership, 2022



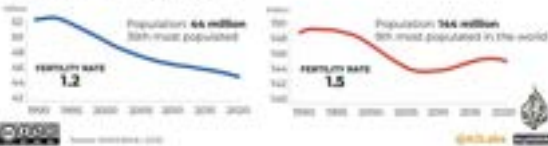
## UKRAINE-RUSSIA CRISIS

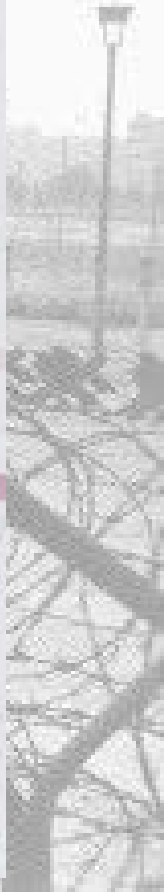

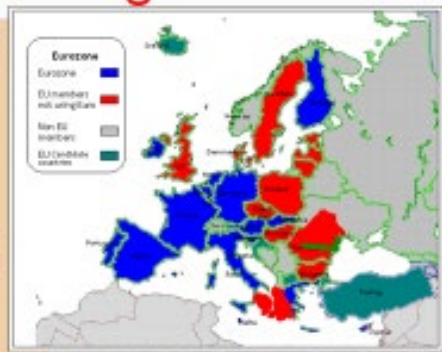
