\rightarrow	One-page comparative essay on Gender, Representation, and Policy Outcomes: EU vs. the US. The essay prompt will ask students to choose a current issue of interest to them related to gender equity and equality, such as equal pay, reproductive rights, family medical leave, addressing violence against women, and the like. Students will compare language in the EU's gender equality strategy and/or the Gender Action Plan with US political party platforms, the stated priorities of relevant US federal agencies, and currently circulating legislation in Congress to analyze how these issues are being addressed in the US vs. the EU. Discussion on Liberal Feminism and Ursula von der Leyen's leadership. Students will be asked to view von der Leyen's speech on International Women's Day and read other critical arguments surrounding Feminist governance to explore the nature of a Liberal Feminist approach to achieving gender equality. Seven to eight short answer, multiple choice, or T/F questions on the EU, the concept of gender mainstreaming, and/or Ursula von der Leyen's leadership will be included in a unit quiz.
