TOPIC Compare/Contrasting the Immigration issue and policies of the EU and US

I.Objective: To have students Analyze the similarities and differences between the dynamics of Immigration between the European Union and the United States.

II. Materials: A. Computer

B. Venn Diagram copy

III. Goal: Building student research skills

IV. Activity:

A. Bellringer Activity: Students are to watch a short video from Euronews on Youtube-Immigration: how do the US and EU compare?- for an Introduction.

- **B**.Classroom Discussion and introduction. topic with students and ask the following essential questions: 1.What is the fundamental difference between US and EU immigration policy (see Bellringer)?
- 2. Where are the immigrants arriving from (both the US and EU)?
- 3. Why are these people immigrating (economic or refugee)?
- 4. What is the attitude of Native European and US citizens toward immigrants? (xenophobia, racism)
- 5 Does economic and/or foreign policy play a role in immigration?
- **C**. Students are to breakout in groups and research topics while discussing the similarities and differences between the EU and US. Students will also discuss and lay a groundwork for contemplating a **Solution for the immigration issue**. (next lesson)
- **D**. Model a Venn Diagram with students. Afterward, a Venn Diagram will be given to the students for them to begin and possibly complete..

Questions and comments" Opportunity for teacher to share experience or opinions.



- Questions: Why is Europe receiving migrants from these areas of the world?- i.e. What is the driving force behind the immigration?




Immigration to the US-Who and Where
