



## Parliamentary Procedure at a Glance

What is it?	How do you phrase it?	What does it mean?	Does it need a second?	Can it be amended?	Is it debatable?	Is a vote needed for it to pass?
<b>Main Motion</b>	"I move that..."	We should do this.	Yes (2)	Yes	Yes	50% + 1 (majority)
<b>Amendment</b>	"I move to amend the motion by..."	I have an idea to make this motion better.	Yes (2)	Yes	Yes	50% + 1 (majority)
<b>Close Debate</b>	"I move the question..."	I think that we should vote.	Yes (2)	No	No	50% + 1 (majority)
<b>Unanimously Close Debate</b>	"I call the question..."	Let's vote – we've all had enough discussion.	No	No	No	100% (consensus)
<b>Correction</b>	"Point of information..."	There's something we should all know about.	No	No	No	No Vote
<b>Personal Privilege</b>	"I raise a point of personal privilege."	I need to make a request relating to personal comfort or to leave the room.	No	No	No	No Vote
<b>Table</b>	"I move to table this motion until..."	For now, let's move on to the next agenda topic.	Yes (2)	No	No	50% + 1 (majority)
<b>Order (!)</b>	"I raise a point of order."	I protest that we're doing something wrong here.	No	No	No	No Vote (Chair Rules)
<b>Remove from the Table</b>	"I move to take up from the table..."	Let's return to a prior agenda topic.	Yes (2)	No	No	50% + 1 (majority)
<b>Temporary Adjournment</b>	"I move for a temporary adjournment on [topic] for X minutes"	The delegates will talk without moderation— usually to try to write a resolution	Yes (2)	No	No	50% + 1 (majority)
