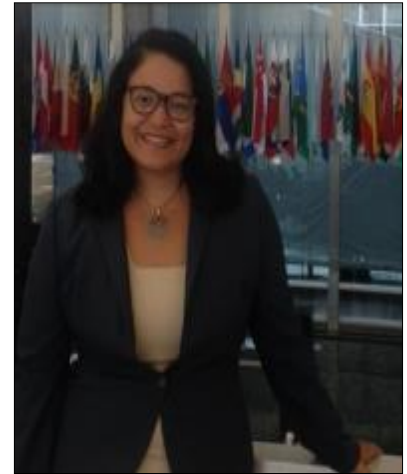


Careers in International Affairs
