Professor O'Callaghan explores the role of collective memory in the Eurozone crisis from a lawyer's perspective. He argues that the idea of collective memory can help us to better understand fundamental aspects of the EU Treaty framework and secondary legislation, and may also provide instructive insights about the policy responses to the Eurozone crisis.
