- 2. Materials purchased must be on *East Asia* (not diaspora, South or Southeast Asia, or Asian Americans); this is a requirement by the funder.
- 3. Materials purchased should be for the benefit of your classroom needs and your entire school.
- 4. Materials purchased should demonstrate some relationship to the material and information you covered in your seminar.
- 5. Please remember that materials for teaching about East Asia vary widely in quality. Not all materials maybe approved for purchase through this grant (this does not apply to the "Pre-approved Sets," see below).
