




Step 1: Type "nctapitt.proboards.com" in your browser address window:





2. Press “back” on your browser to go back and look at a different Thread.


3. To contact a member individually for a personal message, click on “Messages” at the top of menu:

Then click “Create Message,” type the name of the user you wish to contact and send them a message:






